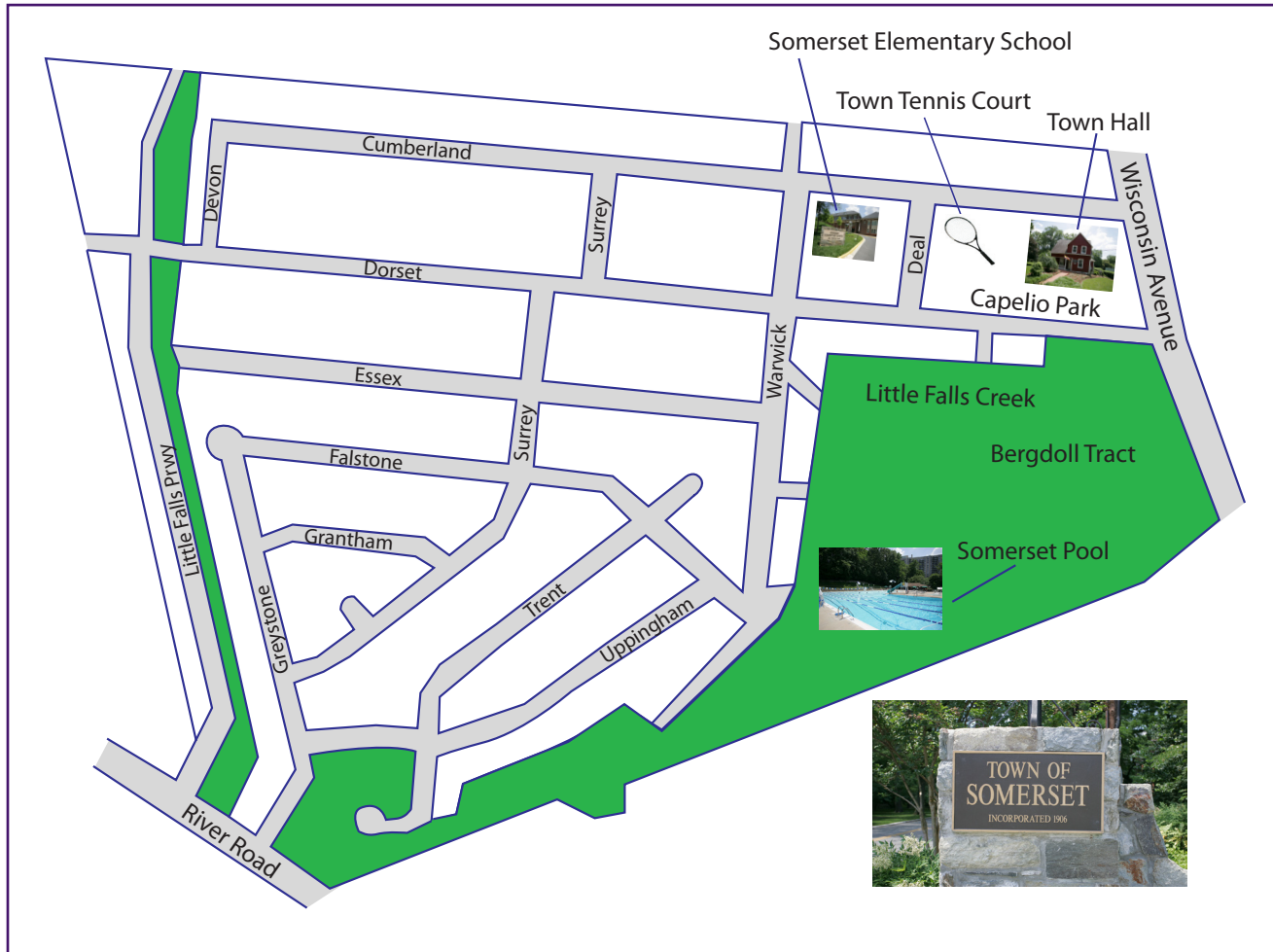




Town of Somerset



The Town of Somerset offers the advantages of small town living combined with proximity to the shops and Metro at Friendship Heights, the Capitol Crescent Trail, and nearby parks. Incorporated in 1906, Somerset is bordered by Wisconsin Avenue to the east, Little Falls Parkway and River Road to the west; Cumberland Avenue to the north, and Somerset House to the south. Home to 410 families, Somerset has an eclectic mix of architectural styles including vintage Victorians, colonials, and ramblers with many interesting renovation and expansion projects.
